

Mel Woolard Peach Cobbler

Makes 8 servings.

3 1 pound cans Peaches	1/2 stick Margarine
1 .5 pound can Crushed pineapple	5 tablespoons Sugar
4 cups Bisquick® baking mix	Cinnamon

1. Drain liquid from 2 cans of peaches into bowl.
2. Mix Bisquick baking mix and 2 tablespoons of sugar with the peach juice. Stir until lumps are gone.
3. Line 12-quart Dutch Oven with aluminum foil.
4. Open 3rd can of peaches and can of pineapple. Drain off juice from both and set aside.
5. Mix 3 cans of peaches and can of pineapple with 3 tablespoons of sugar and pour into Dutch Oven.
6. Sprinkle with cinnamon.
7. Pour Bisquick mixture on top of peach/pineapple mixture.
8. Slice margarine and place pats on top of Bisquick mixture.
9. Put lid on Dutch Oven and set onto 8 pieces of charcoal. Place 18 pieces of charcoal on top of lid.
10. Cook 45-60 minutes, until Bisquick doesn't stick to toothpick and is light brown on top.
